

# Results: North American QSO Party, RTTY— February 2011

Steadily increasing numbers of RTTY operators — aided by a few sunspots — pushed scores to record heights and greatly increased the activity level in the February running of the North American RTTY QSO Party. New records were set in Single Operator, Multi-Two, team and 20 other state/province/country categories. The upswing in sunspot cycle 24 supported welcome contacts on 15 and 10 meters. For example, Rusty, W6OAT, worked 15 states on 10 meters alone.

Don, AA5AU, achieved first place in the Single Operator category, a spot he last held for a February contest in 2004. He also took over the single op score record, which had been held by K3MM since 2005. Perennial winner W6YX at Stanford University led the Multi-Two category and set a new record, while the mighty SWACC#1 Team topped the team competition and bested the team record. Twenty-eight teams contributed to the high activity, especially from the NCCC (five teams), TCG (four teams) and SWACC (three teams).

Noteworthy were the many stations reporting how much *fun* they had. Our thanks
