

Results: North American QSO Party RTTY— July 2012

The July 2012 running of the North American QSO Party's RTTY version attracted 395 entries and generated a lot of activity. This is the highest number of July entries ever received, although participation in the February running remains about 20 percent greater.

Single Operator

In the Single Operator category, Dean, NØXR, finished in first place from the NØNI station. Dean says he's been extremely fortunate to participate in many multioperator efforts from NØNI, and he occasionally gets to use the station for solo efforts in such events as NAQPs and Sprints. In second place was Don, AA5AU, using a new 80 meter inverted V. Unfortunately, Don's antennas suffered more hurricane damage in August. Our February winner W7RN — operated by Jeff, WK6I — took third place. "Murf," N7UVH, was our QRP winner, using only 15, 20 and 40 meters.

Multi-Two

In the Multi-Two category, KU5B, operating at NX5M, took the top spot in their first attempt at the NAQP RTTY. The NX5M station has been growing for 12 years, but only this year did it start operating RTTY. Team members NX5M, KU5B, KJ5T and N5XJ, enjoyed being able to talk with each other while operating RTTY. On 20 meters alone, they logged an impressive 490 contacts. Second place went to reliable entrant W6YX, with K6UFO, K6YL, K2ZV, N6DQ, N7MH, ND2T and W6LD pitching in, with their highest July score so far. WW4LL (K1ZZI, K9MUG and WW4LL) has been very competitive recently and placed third. What a terrific spread of winners from across the country — Iowa,

Louisiana, Nevada, Texas, California and Georgia!

Teams

In team competition, the SWACC #1 led the 37 team entries, followed by the NCCC#1 team. Rounding out the top three were the SMC Diddlers #1. Many teams racked up scores well north of 100,000 total points. *Well done!*
