

Results: North American QSO Party SSB — January 2013

Reading the soapbox comments I have to question at times if I'm reading about the same contest. The comments range from "Fun, Fun, Fun" to a simple "Ugh!" As I read them, I wondered if one area of the country is favored over another. So, I categorized the comments by state to see if I could find a pattern. While it appeared the Central Atlantic region may have had the worst conditions, the multioperator team at WX3B in Maryland did set a personal best score. Further analysis revealed that most stations experienced good conditions, and people enjoyed the contest. We had 884 Single-Operator entries (including 21 DX) as well as 57 Multioperator, Two Transmitter entries this time.

Other operators setting personal best scores included Ryan, KB9OWD; Matt, KB9UWU (as WR9D); Mike, W9RE; Felipe, NP4Z, and Mark, W4SVO. Congratulations to everyone who set a personal best score.

One terrific thing about the NAQP is the low power and simple exchange — great ways to introduce newcomers to contesting. Doing just this was Bob, K0BH, who coached Rhett and Jake of the Hesston College ARC in their first NAQP event at K0HC. This was Jake's very first contest experience. According to Bob, Jake "really picked up fast and says he will be back." Bob also appreciated everyone's patience working the beginning contesters. Another group

providing beginning contest experience was the Portland DX RCC at KK7PR. They also had a first time operator, Rick, K7RIK.

Adding to the fun are the special event stations. This contest found N3A commemorating the 2013 Presidential Inauguration. Ken, KE3X, played president for the day using "Jack" (for Jack Kennedy). This special event station was sponsored by the District of Columbia ARS. While not at a special event station, Charles, W4PBG, activated K3NEM at the National Electronics Museum, using the name "Chip." Judging from the website (www.nationalelectronicmuseum.org), it looks like a fun place to be, and it must have been interesting operating surrounded by all that historic gear.

Single-Operator

The Single-Operator category had 858 entries, almost double the number from the August event. Finishing first was Bill, K4XS, who was returning after a nearly 7 year break. Rich, N6KT, piloted W6NL to second place, an improvement of two positions from last January. Felipe at NP4Z finished third. Less than 3 percent separated the first and third-place finishers. The rest of the Top 10 included Rich, NN3W, at N4RV in Virginia; Kevin, N5DX, in Arkansas; Fred, KK1KW, in New Hampshire; Matt, NQ6N, in New York;

Chad, WE9V, in Wisconsin; Mike, W9RE, in Indiana, and Rich, WC6H in California. Chad is also returning to the Top 10 box after a couple of years' break from the contest.

QRP

Moving into the top spot in the QRP category was Brian, N4OO, in Georgia. In August, Brian finished a distant second. Finishing second this time was Glenn, K2FF, operating NA5NN in Mississippi. Dropping to third place after his top finish in August was Randy, ND0C, in Minnesota. Rounding out the top five were Ron, W4UT, and Ken, KS4X, both in Tennessee.

Multioperator, Two Transmitter

Returning back to the top spot in the M2 category was the team at NX5M in Texas. Dropping down a spot from their August finish was WX3B in Maryland, finishing second but with a new personal best score. Moving up two positions into third was W6YX in California. Placing fourth and fifth were WW4LL in Georgia, and NC4KW in North Carolina.

Team Competition

With increased participation the number of teams increased to 74 this time. Finishing in the top spot was the NCCC #1 team, which had three team members in the Top 10. Finishing second was the SMC team of Dead

Combined Score

Leveraging his SSB third place finish, Felipe, NP4Z, took the top spot in the combined scores. Taking the second spot was Mike, W9RE with his ninth place SSB finish. In third place was Matt, NQ6N, with his seventh place SSB finish. It's worth noting that these top three finishers in the combined score did not make it into the Top 10 of the CW event.
