

Results: North American Sprint, Phone—February 2011

We received 51 logs for this running of the phone Sprint, down from last February. In general scores also were lower, although a good variety of multipliers were available. Danny, K7SS, had 52 mults, which is the highest total since September 2005. Among others he worked Martinique, St Lucia and VE8. Even so, here is a partial list of multipliers that others work but Danny missed: Antigua, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Guadeloupe, US Virgin Islands, VE2, VE4, VE6 and Utah. If Danny had found all of those multipliers he would have established any all-time multiplier total record.

High Power

K7SS easily notched his ninth High Power win, with the highest QSO and multiplier total. There were no meters like 40 meters for Danny, with almost 70 percent of his contacts on that band. Contrast that to KA9FOX, who finished second. Scott had almost identical contact totals on all three bands. N6ED, K6LL, and W9RE rounded out the Top Five. The second half of the High Power Top 10 also had its share of West Coast and Midwest stations, although N1LN and K4BAI made rare appearances from the Southeastern US. The second half was in this order: KW8N, K6LA, N1LN, K4BAI, and WDØT. This marked the first time that John, K4BAI, landed in the High Power Top 10.

Low Power

N5DO, Dave, is starting a new Low Power winning streak, with his second straight win from Texas. N6ZFO easily finished second, but there was a close battle for third place, with NA4BW edging out WØETT by just 48 points. Brian had six more multipliers, while Ken had 16 more contacts. The remaining stations in the Low Power Top 10 were WWØAL, N9CK, ACØW, NA4K, N7VS, and WW9R. It was WWØAL's first time in the Top 10.

QRP

Winning QRP for the first time was NN7SS, followed by NDØC and NØOU.

Golden Logs

Logging "golden" (no deductions) with 50 or more contacts were K4BAI, WDØT, NA4K, and W1WBB. *Great job!* If you want a copy of your log checking report, send an
