

# Results: North American Sprint, SSB — March 2013

With a new date in March, plenty of ops found their way to the new contest period and helped the airwaves quickly come alive with close races in all power categories. Although the new date coincides with the Russian DX contest, even some participants in that contest took a moment to jump into the Sprint and hand out a few contacts — band sharing and contest cooperation at its best!

## Top Scorers

The High Power category often brings out the best of the best to compete for the win. This was no exception as Bill, K4XS, was onboard to defend his title. In a fantastic effort, Bill managed to score the most contacts in the contest, yet was unable to defeat veteran Sprint contesteer Dan, K7SS, who, owing to several more multipliers, secured the win in the category and the overall high score.

In the Low Power category, the trophy goes to David, N5DO. In a tight race for second, Bill, KØUK, edged out Jason, W1UJ.

I was particularly excited to see such an active QRP category, with seven entrants. Randy, NDØC, squeezed ahead of Rodney, W7ZRC, for the gold.

## Team Competition

It is important to remember that, unlike the smaller NAQP teams, SSB Sprint teams can include up to 10 members each, with no geographical restrictions. The Northern California Contest Club submitted two Sprint teams this time around. The 10 member NCCC #1 team handily secured the team sweepstakes from the West Coast. The six members of the MRRC/NCC team took second, with a team-leading score by veteran sprinter KW8N and other strong performances from the group. SMC#1 took third, led by another veteran, Mike, W9RE.

Thanks to all for participating in the relocated March running of the SSB Sprint. We appreciate the cooperation (and even participation) of operators in the concurrent contests that weekend. It demonstrates the high standards and operating excellence of the Amateur Radio contest community.
