

Results: North American QSO Party, CW, January 2026

The January 2026 North American QSO Party (NAQP) started like most others. The bands exploded with activity at 1800Z, with operators shoveling contacts at a rapid pace. Montana seems to be a good location for this event, and Pat, N9RV, proved this with a massive 343 contacts in the first hour. He backed that up with 301 contacts in the subsequent hour; however, due to Tom's, 8P5A, score, he would not win the Single Operator Unassisted category this year. Assisted guru Bud, AA3B, did not have near these contact rates, as is usually the case from eastern parts of the country, but he was able to put many valuable multipliers in the log on 10 and 15 meters, which would once again boost him to the top of the Assisted standings. In the Multi-Two category, all the usual suspects were present, but this time there were two teams made up specifically of World Radiosport Team Championship (WRTC) 2026 teammates who came together to test gear and practice for the big event in July. When the dust settled, one of these teams would finish in the top position.

This year, solar activity threw a wrench into the plans of many participants. Shortly before 2000Z, a coronal mass ejection, combined with impacts related to a coronal hole, shifted the Earth's magnetic field from active to storm levels, and the K-Index jumped to 7. Northern skies turned green with aurora, and the bands sounded like a wet blanket had been thrown over them. Most comments indicated that 40 meters suffered the most, though conditions seemed to recover somewhat toward the end of the

contest, helping those who planned their off times wisely to mitigate the damage. In the Unassisted category, only one station made more than 2,000 contacts — down nearly 500 from the top score a year ago — but a minimum of 1,400 contacts was still needed to make the Top 10 box, so there was still rate to be made despite the solar hiccup.

Single-Operator Low Power

Pat, N9RV, got off to a fantastic start before the solar disturbance hit. Afterwards, operating turned into quite a struggle as aurora began to attenuate the bands. Being south had its benefits, and Tom, 8P5A, was able to maintain a better rate through the affected hours. Tom performed particularly well on the low bands, considering his location so far to the south and east of the North American population centers, and finished with the win as the only Single Operator to break 2,000 contacts. N9RV finished second, followed closely by Chris, KL9A, operating as KM7W, who fell just short in total contacts despite winning the multiplier battle. Fourth and fifth place were both taken by Texas stations, with Dave, K5GN, just edging out Robert, K5PI, operating from the K5TR superstation. A special mention must be made for youth operator Kees, W0AAE, who made more than 1,600 contacts and another top-ten finish. Kees seems to have figured out how to efficiently run Two Bands Synchronized Interleaved QSOs (2BSIQ), and they will likely be someone to watch for many years to come.

Single-Operator QRP

Brian, N2MF, navigated his way through the solar disturbance and finished with a very respectable 667 QSOs and a commanding first-place finish in the Unassisted QRP category. Second place went to another station in New York, with a strong showing by Will, NQ2W. Third place went to part-time participant Alan, K0AV.

Single-Operator Low Power Assisted

Bud, AA3B, continued to put on a master class in operating the Assisted category and once again pulled away for the top spot. Bud was able to break away from the competition in the later hours of the contest when most others struggled with conditions. Gator, N5RZ, finished in second place from Texas. Like AA3B, Gator also operated classic SO2R, and it's interesting how this differs from the 2BSIQ strategy that dominates the top Unassisted standings. Third place went to Dave, N2NL, with single-radio user John, W8FJ, in fourth and state QSO party mobile operator extraordinaire Jim, AD4EB, in fifth.

Single-Operator Assisted QRP

If you hear a weak guy calling with a Vibroplex bug, you could guess it's Danny, K7SS, and usually be right. Danny, fittingly, used the name "Bugs," which threw off some folks trying to dig his name out of the noise. Second place went to Rob, K4OV, operating from North Carolina.

Multi-Two

As mentioned previously, a couple of WRTC teammates joined

up and used the NAQP CW as a practice session for the July event. Marko, N5ZO, and Axel, KI6RRN, teamed up with station host Tim, N6WIN, filling in for bathroom breaks to operate ND7K to the top of the standings and very narrowly beating the three-man team at ZF5T. A couple of QSOs or one extra multiplier could have been the difference to swap standings. A remote team operated NP3Y to a very close third place, with N2NT in fourth. Fifth place went to another WRTC practice team, with Steve, N2IC, joining Bob, K5WA, to operate from Bob's station in Texas.

Team Scores

The always-competitive Deep Dixie CC Team Elvis won the team competition, with members Mitch, K7RL; Torsten, N4OGW; Gary, K5KU; Tim, ABØS, and Kenny, N5EE. Their 1.75 million total was just enough to overcome the 1.72-million-point entry by The Zoomers.

In Closing

It's worth spotlighting the operation by Dean, N6DE, who made a very respectable 700 QSOs from a portable location at a state park. Dean used very modest inverted-v antennas at only 20 feet, but he was set up at the edge of a very steep drop-off toward the rest of North America, in an area with no local noise. After the contest, he did an in-depth signal strength comparison with nearby big-gun stations, and the results showed that, thanks to the favorable terrain, he had a very competitive signal despite his limited hardware. The low-power, 12-hour format of the NAQP contests make them ideal for such an operation. These Parks on the Air® style operations may be the answer for those who find themselves living in an antenna-restricted community, or those who have a high noise floor

at their home station. The August NAQP may be the perfect opportunity to get outside and try operating portable.

There are a number of very gracious clubs and individuals who sponsor plaques in the six NAQP events held each year. NAQP SSB Contest Manager Bill, ACØW, currently handles all the details involved with getting plaques ordered and shipped, and he will continue to do so even after turning management of the NAQP SSB over to Dan, N6MJ, this summer.
