The Multi-Two competition was much closer this time than it usually is. The Ops at K0RF just edged out the gang at W5NN with another regular, N0NI also very close behind. Again, the primary difference was in finding the multipliers. It's interesting to note that Jeff, N5TJ found 4 more Mults than the winning Multi-Two entry did! Maybe he has a split personality and each one takes a rig? Ok Ok, it's just a theory... At least it looks like everyone had fun.

The team competition was won by the Texas Association of Contest Operators (T.A.C.O.)'s, Team #1. I had to spell that out for those who didn't know what the TACO's were. For quite a while, I didn't! These guys have been hard at it trying for an NAQP Team Win for a while now. Looks like have arrived! Rounding out the Top 4 spots were teams from the Tennessee Contest Group, Potomac Valley Radio Club and the Kentucky Contest Group. A total of 23 teams pre-registered this time again demonstrating that Team Contesting is still a popular aspect of the NA Contests. There seems to be quite a rivalry brewing between Tennessee and Kentucky. Florida for that matter too. Better keep an eye on CNN to see if an outbreak of some kind occurs!
