I knew that it was only a matter of time — regardless of the status of the sunspot cycle — that a station in the multi-two category would surpass the 1000 contact level. Congratulations to the team at W6YX (K6OWL, K6UFO, KI6CCH, N6DE, N7MH, W6LD and W6RK) for accomplishing this feat. Their team score was $1034 \times 194 = 200,596$ points, outdistancing the NI7T team (NI7T and W7CT).

In the single op category, K7MI overtook AA5AU, who returned this year after a two-year absence. K6LL, W0YK and AD6WL round out the top five.

Among the single-op DX entries, CT3KY edged out fellow countryman CT3EN for the top spot.

SWACC #1 returned to the top spot in team competition.

New records were established by WQ2N (NJ), K7MI (OR), W7LD (WA) and VY2SS (PEI).
