

Results: North American QSO Party, RTTY — February 2025

Our February running of the NAQP RTTY contest was “right down the middle.” Neither 10 meters nor 80 meters was as good as last year, but the “middle” bands — 15, 20, and 40 meters — performed well. Solar flux was 199 with an A Index of 7, both right in the middle for this point at the peak of the sunspot cycle. Also, no extreme cold weather events as in previous years. Several ops reported being outside, in a park or on a POTA (Parks on the Air) expedition.

At the start of the contest, 10 meters was busy, with the 6s and 7s working the long skip to the USA East Coast. The Caribbean DX operations of NP3Y and VP5M were also boosted by 10 — and the race was on! In the “middle” states, the band was disappointing, as reported by Leroy, KØWA: “10 meters never showed up in Kansas. I could hear the coasts working each other, but here...just nothing.”

After a few hours, the activity had moved up to 15 and 20 meters, and the usual suspects tried establishing their leads. Multi-two expert Ace, NJ4P, in Tennessee, passed up the 6s, then circled around the top spot with the DX stations. Most single-ops take their break in the late afternoon, to save time for 80 meters late at night, near the end. But 80 performed its best around 03Z and 04Z, and 40 was “better” through all that, performing well from 00Z right up to 05Z.

In Single-Operator, W7RN in Nevada (operated once again by Jeff, WK6I) reached first place with 222 QSOs on 10 meters, and a good spread on the rest of the bands. This may be the last NAQP RTTY from W7RN, as the property is up for

sale. Second place went to Steve, N9CK, in Wisconsin, with very good accuracy but lagging W7RN on 15 and 10-meter QSOs. (See Table 1 for Top Ten.)

In Single-Operator QRP (Table 2), Bob, W7YAQ, made 140 QSOs to nab the top spot, without making a single QSO on 10 meters.

In Single-Operator Assisted (Table 3), Mitch, K7RL, held the top spot, bolstered by 200 QSOs on 10 meters. His closest challenger, Bud, AA3B, had only 65 QSOs on 10 — but 209 Qs on 80 meters, where K7RL only managed 143. They were closely followed by Ty, K3MM, in Maryland; Ken, WØLSD, in Colora-

do, and Dave, WD6T, in California at the N6RO station. Being “assisted” certainly boosted their scores, as the average multiplier count for the top five assisted stations was 235, while the un-assisted entrants averaged only 200.

In Single-Operator Assisted QRP (Table 4), Jim, W7RY, in Missouri, rocketed to the top spot with an excellent 184 multipliers.

In Multi-Two (Table 5), it was Ace, NJ4P, in Tennessee with a stellar team of ops who kept the boiler hot from beginning to end, and held off Bob, K8IA, in Arizona; Paul, NP3Y, in Puerto Rico (who lost their remote connection for the last hours), and

All told, nine operations claimed over 1,000 QSOs, so there was good activity on the bands.

In team competition (Table 6), it was again SWACC #1, which recruited five operators who all finished in their respective Top Tens. Not far behind were the NCCC Baud Busters and the Deep Dixie Contest Club Team Elvis. A total of 31 teams shows how popular it is to form a team and join your club members and friends.

In the North American Collegiate Championship, William, AI5OD, operated W9YH at the University of Illinois in Urbana-Champaign (see photo) and reported “The

contest was a blast! Always fun to see lots of digital activity on the bands.”
